Project Updates

Non – Food Rewards – Tables will be set up at both the county and city school inservices on August 29. A copy of the entry form was reviewed and we added additional questions to use as a pre-evaluation piece.

Walk and Bike to School – National walk and bike to school day is October 3rd. It was decided that we would send a flier to all schools that encouraged walking and biking to school on October 3rd. We would encourage all schools to send these fliers home with their students. Melissa will contact the Herald and News and see if they would do a story on walk and bike to school day to increase awareness.

School Wellness Column – At the previous HAK meeting the food service directors informed us of their plan to include some sort of wellness section of their menus and we offered our assistance with this project. Melissa said that she would contact Jean and Ginger to see if they would still be interested in us helping them out. Our other option would be to do our own column in the school newsletters. Patty asked Melissa if she would be able to put this together if information was given to her and she said yes. We will decide once we hear back from the food service directors.
